ROSE SHOW CONDITIONS OF EXHIBITING

1. The hall will be open for exhibitors at 6am on Sunday 17th May. All exhibits must be staged by 9am when all Exhibitors must leave the Exhibition area. No exhibit shall be removed before closing time-4pm Sunday.
2. All roses will be judged under National Rose Society of Australia Standards.
3. Judges decision will be final.
4. All exhibits must be staged in containers provided by the Roselovers' Association.
5. Care will be taken with exhibits but the Committee will not be responsible for any loss or damage to any exhibit.
6. All blooms must be grown by the Exhibitor.
7. Exhibits must have a Variety Card for each entry with the Exhibitors Number written on the back (to preserve anonymity). Exhibitors can obtain a number from Len Johnstone, The Roselovers' Association Public Relations Officer (3366 4669).
8. Entries close on Thursday 14th May 2009 at 9pm. Entries can be sent direct to the Public Relations Officer, 64 Buckingham Street, St. Johns' Wood 4060.
9. Late entries will be accepted if space permits.

CLASS 2 PATIO OR MINI-FLORA CHAMPIONSHIP

6 STEM/CUTS Patio (mini-Flora) roses N.N.D. (in one container.)

3 stem/cuts Patio mini-flora roses 1 cultivar (in one container.)

3 stem/cuts Patio mini-flora roses Distinct (in one container.)

CLASS 3 MINIATURE CHAMPIONSHIP

6 stems Minis N.N.D. (in one container.)

3 stem/cuts Minis one cultivar (in one container.)

3 stem/cuts Minis Distinct (in one container.)

CLASS 4 FLORIBUNDA CHAMPIONSHIP

6 stem/cuts Floribundas N.N.D. (in one container.)

3 stem/cuts Floribundas one cultivar (in one container.)

3 stem/cuts Floribundas Distinct (in one container.)

CLASS 14 3 stems Mini roses – 1 bloom per stem in 3 stages of opening—one stage must be in full bloom –1 cultivar in vertical arrangement (in one container) Wiring permitted.

CLASS 18 1 cut Patio (mini-flora) rose

CLASS 19 3 stems (mini-flora) roses N.N.D. (in one container)

CLASS 20 3 stems (mini-flora) roses 1 cultivar (in one container)

CLASS 21 3 stems (mini-flora) roses Distinct (in one container)

SECTION 5

CLASS 22 3 cuts Patio (mini-flora) roses N.N.D. (in one container)

CLASS 23 3 cuts Patio (mini-flora) 1 cultivar. (in one container)

CLASS 24 3 cuts Patio (mini-flora) roses Distinct (in one container)

CLASS 25 3 stems Patio (mini-flora) roses in 3 stages of opening –one stage must be in full bloom in vertical arrangement –1 cultivar (one container) Wiring permitted.

CLASS 26 6 stems Patio (mini-flora) roses 1 Bloom per stem N.N.D.(in one container)



N.B. A stem has one flower and a cut has more than one flower

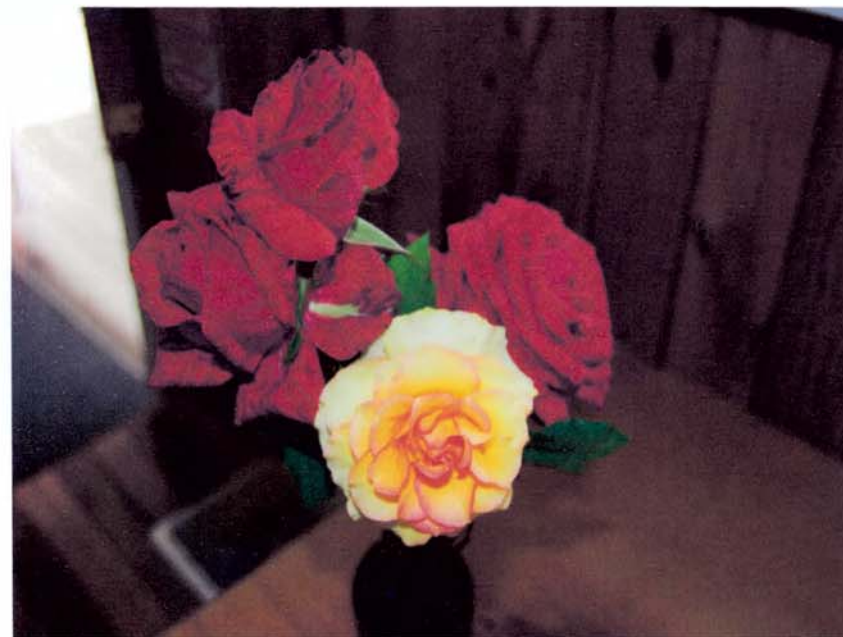

- ✚ NND means "not necessary distinct", which allows the Exhibitor to mix and match varieties in the exhibit to suit available roses (e.g. 3 stems NND would allow a choice of either 3 distinct cultivars, 3 of 1 cultivar, or 2 of 1 cultivar and 1 of another different cultivar).
- ✚ 3 distinct cultivars means 3 differently named roses.
- ✚ 1 cultivar has the same meaning as 1 variety (same name).
